SASAHARA COMPLETES FORMULA RENAULT LINE UP FOR EURONOVA



Euronova Racing is proud to announce its third and final driver for this season's Formula Renault Alps campaign. Japanese youngster Ukyo Sasahara will line up alongside Euronova's previously confirmed drivers – Gregor Ramsay from Great Britain and Javier Amado of Venezuela.

Sasahara, who will celebrate his 17th birthday in April, was born in Numata-city and is currently studying in Austria. He started racing in karts in 2003 and has won 13 titles to date. He took part in some single seater testing early in 2012 and had his first experience with Euronova in November, testing one of their Formula Abarth cars.

Sasahara's Formula Renault programme kicked off yesterday with the first day of a two day test at Misano and will continue next week at Monza.

Sasahara: I'm very happy to have this opportunity to drive with the Euronova team. After testing with them in Barcelona in December myself and all my team worked very hard to achieve this and I would like to thank them all for their support. I am very excited about this year which will be my first season in single seater racing and will be focusing very hard on testing and on physical training in preparation for the opening race.

Sospiri: Ukyo will be a great asset to the team and I am very pleased to have him join us and to conclude our Formula Renault line up for this season. We have a really international team this year and I am confident that we will achieve good results with all three drivers.
