3. SUPPLIED EQUIPMENT FOR THE RACE

(on a free of charge loan basis for the period of the Grand Finals 2017)

- Complete rolling chassis/trolley with seat plus engine package (rims for wet tyres will get handed out in case of rain only) which has to be returned at the determined time of the time schedule after respective last race, under following conditions.
 - Complete kart with engine and accessories must be returned in clean conditions as required by the chassis partner.
 - Carburettor and radiator must be empty. Driver must replace broken or damaged parts at their own costs before return. Required spare parts for engines and kart chassis are available at the ROTAX spare parts and the chassis partner spare parts shop at the race track. Prices according to valid price list.
 - In case of a failure of any engine package component during the RMCGF you have to contact the responsible ROTAX person at the workshop, to decide if the failure is covered under warranty (costs for repair taken over by BRP-ROTAX) or an engine failure caused by misuse or race accident (costs for repair has to be taken over by the customer).



**Illegal manipulations on engines, parts, chassis, tyres etc. will automatically lead to disqualification and exclusion from the whole event.
In doubt if something is legal or not, please contact one of the scrutineers at the track in advance.**

Please keep in mind that this package is owned by the chassis manufacturers and they will check the products at return of goods.

- **Gear ratios:**
All parts for the different gear ratios allowed during the event:

- **Transponder:**
A transponder including support will be handed over for free usage during the event. It must be returned at the track according to time schedule. Where or to whom will be announced at the drivers briefing.
Transponders must be mounted according to the information included in the driver's kit.
Mounting device handed out together with Transponder **MUST** be used.
The driver only is responsible for lost transponders during races.

4. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR SUPPLIED EQUIPMENT:

- Karts must be used as supplied with all its original equipment.
- Personal data recording is allowed to be used! (Track is equipped with ALFANO strips)
- Only tyres (dry + wet) and pre-mixed fuel which will be handed out in Servicing park are legal to use throughout the whole event.
Tyres will stay in Servicing park (except during free practice)

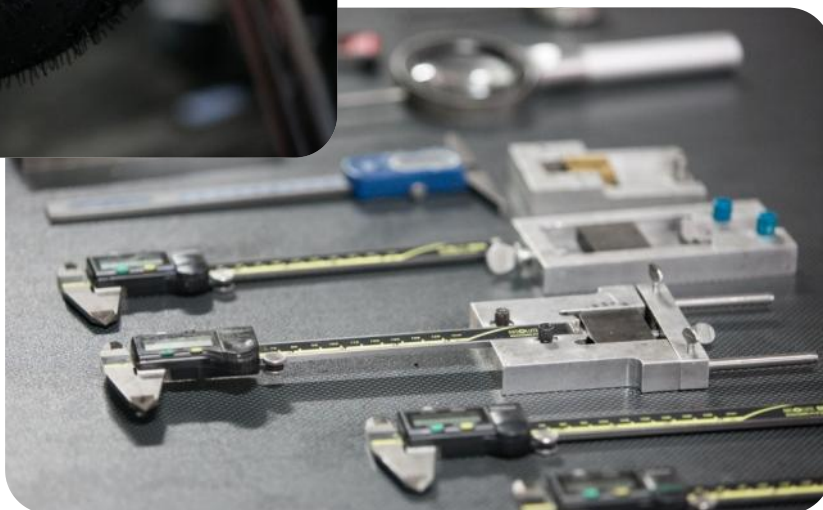

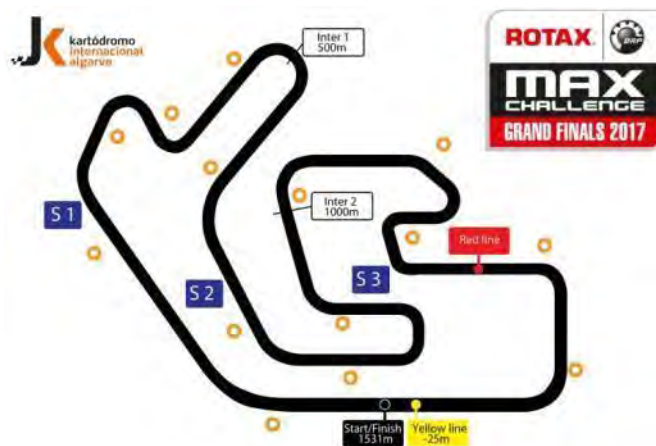

6. THE TRACK



Kartodrómo Internacional do Algarve



The track is located in the Algarve hills eight kilometres northwest of Portimão. It is part of the ultra-modern “Algarve Motor Park”, a multi-purpose area suited for a wide range of uses. Races of many national and international championships on two and four wheels took place since it opened its doors in 2008. The Kart-Track itself was opened in 2010.

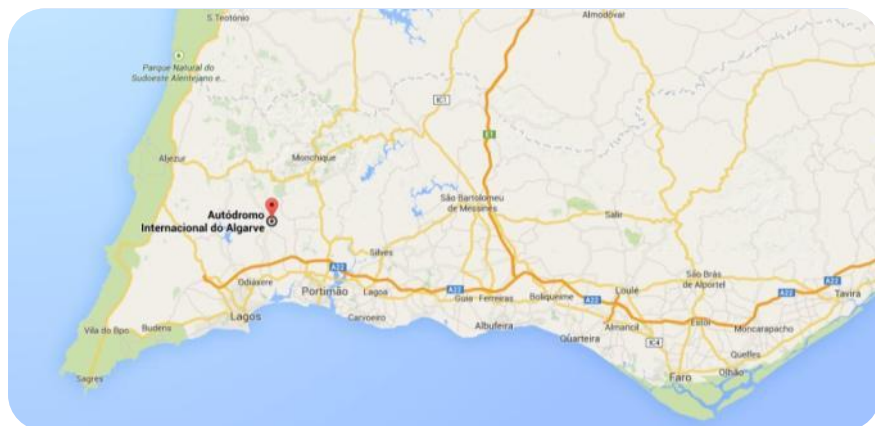
The track is 1.532 m long and 8 m wide. The main straight is approximately 150 m long and 10 m wide. The circuit is a combination of undulating sections, many changes of direction, long corners, and a winding infield.

7. COUNTRY INFORMATION / PORTUGAL

- Time Zone:** Portimão is in the West European Time (WET) or West European Summer Time (WEST) and is 1 hour ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT +1)
- Climate:** The Western Algarve enjoys a Mediterranean climate, with hot dry summers and mild wet winters. The period from the end of May until mid-September is dry, with only 6% of the annual rainfall occurring during that period. But also in autumn and winter, the weather is generally mild with temperatures around 8–17°C (46–63°F).
- Language:** The official language is Portuguese.
- Electricity:** The standard electrical voltage in Portugal is 220-230 V AC / 50 Hz as opposed to the 110-120 V/ 60 Hz North American standards. Thus, a transformer and an adapter are needed for North American electrical appliances as well as appliances from possible further foreign countries. Electrical sockets (outlets) in Portugal are one of the two European standard electrical socket types: Europlug and Schuko.
- Currency:** Euro / €
- Driving:** Traffic travels on the right in Portugal.
- Speed limits:***
City 35mph/56kph, Open Roads 55mph/88kph, Highways 75mph/120kph
- Driving licence:***
Drivers without an EU driving licence are allowed to drive with an official translation or an International Drivers Permit (IDP) that accompanies the foreign licence.
- Safety equipment:***
The driver is expected to carry a replacement tire and the respective tools needed, reflective vests for driver and passengers as well as warning triangles. The reflector vest must be worn by any person carrying out repairs when outside the vehicle and the vehicle is stationary on the road.
- The warning triangle is mandatory, and it must be displayed on the road to warn oncoming drivers that your vehicle has problems.
A replacement bulb set is also mandatory. First-aid kit is advised, but not compulsory.
- The use of mobile phones is banned and if caught you will be heavily fined. The roads of Portugal are extremely clean because of the strict anti-litter laws imposed. Fines for littering can go up to €300.
- Alcohol limit:** Portugal has strict drinking-and-driving laws. The amount of alcohol allowed in the blood while driving is 0.5‰ (0.25mg/l)
- Vaccination:** non-compulsory

8. REQUIREMENTS TO ENTER PORTUGAL



Passport and Visa

To enter Portugal, you may need a Passport and/or a Visa, depending on the country you live in. Citizens from the European Community don't need a Visa for entering Portugal. Portugal is also a signatory to the 1995 Schengen Agreement.

Passports must be valid for up to six months (depending on your nationality) and are required by all, except by European Union nationals and nationals of Iceland, Liechtenstein, Malta, Norway and Switzerland holding valid national ID cards. British, Australian, Canadian, American and Japanese need a valid passport.

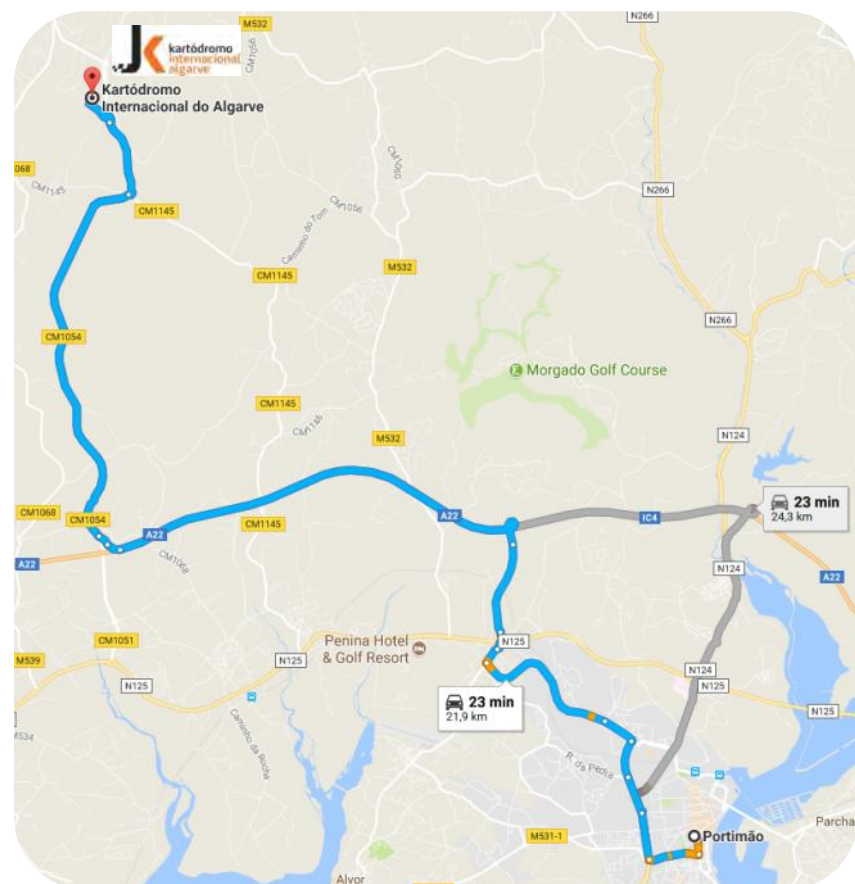

16. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Can I train at the track before the event?

Training for qualified drivers is allowed up to 4 weeks prior to the event (=start of registration), means **October 6, 2017 is the last day for training.**

Driving rental karts is allowed before the event.

2. Which travel route is recommended?

The closest airport to the city is Faro Airport, which is approximately 60km east of Portimão Center. As the track is also a bit outside of the center, the direct connection between Faro Airport and the track is ~80 km. (pls. see point 9 – Travel information)

3. Do I need a visa to enter / stay in Europe?

Depending on your nationality, there are different visa requirements to consider. Some citizens of non-EU countries are required to hold a visa when travelling to the Schengen area. In case of required visa, the application needs to be made at the Embassy / Consulate where you will be staying for the maximum number of days.

(see point 8 – Requirements to enter Portugal)

4. Can I move within Europe?

A short-stay visa issued by one of the Schengen States entitles its holder to travel throughout the 26 Schengen States for up to three months within a six-month period without any further registration/documents needed.

5. Do I need a special driving license to rent and drive a rental car?

No, your national driving license will do. Pls. check with your local automobile federation.

Drivers without an EU driving license are allowed to drive with an official translation or an International Drivers Permit (IDP) that accompanies the foreign license.

6. Should I get a rental car during my stay at the Grand Finals?

Yes, we recommend a rental car even though all locations are in a range of max. 30 minutes from the track. GUERIN/ENTERPISE provides special conditions for the Grand Finals! (pls. see point 11 – Rental car service)

7. Do I need any insurance?

We strongly recommend that you obtain comprehensive travel and medical insurance before traveling. You should check any exclusion and that your policy covers you for the activities you want to undertake as well as an emergency return insurance.

8. What arrival time is recommended for drivers?

NEW: Driver registration is possible on Saturday Nov. 4th only to let you sign up more flexible and without a hassle.

9. Who provides the chassis?

The chassis partners in 2017 are IPKarting with its Praga chassis for the Rotax 125 Junior MAX category, Sodikart supporting the Rotax 125 MAX and Rotax 125 MAX DD2 Masters class and BirelART supporting the event in the Rotax 125 MAX DD2 category.

10. What type of chassis will be used?

125 MICRO MAX: PRAGA
125 MINI MAX: BIRELART
125 Junior MAX Junior: PRAGA
125 MAX: SODIKART
125 MAX DD2: BIRELART
125 MAX DD2 Masters: SODIKART

11. How many engines and carburettors does each driver get?

1 engine with all its ancillaries (incl. 1 carburettor) and battery charger with EU plug.

12. Who provides the space in tents and what does the driver and mechanic get in terms of help, tools and so on?

Each driver gets a space allocated, a complete tool box as well as a kit of kart maintenance products (chains spray, brake cleaner...). Electricity is supplied free of charge. Drivers will be supported by mechanics of the chassis brand they will use in this class as well as people of BRP-Rotax regarding the engine.

13. How do I get spare parts if needed?**Are they provided free of charge or need to be bought?**

All spare parts for chassis and engines are available at a shop on site.
In case a part of an engine or chassis is to be replaced or damaged supplier will decide if it's covered under warranty. If not parts have to get purchased at usual market prices.

14. Can I use my own carburettor or exhaust?

NO, all carburettors and exhausts are marked with a number, others are illegal.

15. Do I need to bring any chassis parts?

NO, only parts which are available on site are legal.

16. Do I have to bring the necessary tools?

No, but you can (akku drill, etc.)

17. What kind of seats are provided or should the drivers take their own?

Only original seats (as supplied for each class) are allowed, drivers have to decide on seat size needed (all sizes will be available).

If due to physical reasons you need a special seat pls. let us know and bring it with you, officials will decide if you will be allowed to use it or not.

18. Can I bring my own axle, seat, stub axle, etc.?

NO
