1.1. Online Registration

All qualified drivers must register online at *https://www.rotax-ems.com/brp* in advance. Alternatively, you may tab the Grand Finals 2019 register button on the Rotax Homepage. The required password to enter the online registration will be provided by your national Rotax Distributor. Lines are open:

For your online registration please prepare:

- Your personal data and those of your entrant
- Your passport number
- Your driver license number
- Your personal transponder number*

* It is mandatory to have your own transponder.

- Your entrants (competitors) license number
- Picture of driver and entrant licences (jpg, max. 1MB)

After a successful online registration, you will receive a confirmation email with all required documents. See chapter 1.2 how to treat them. The confirmation email also contains your personal EDIT-code and Rotax WiFi access data.

EDIT-CODE

This is your personal EDIT-Code (as a string and QR) which you will need later on to:

- modify your data, if necessary
- fill up the commentator's sheet
- login to the Rotax Global App

ROTAX WIFI

There are two access data pairs (one for you and another one for your entrant) each consisting of username and password which you can use to connect to the free Rotax WiFi on site. A setup guide for iOS and Android is contained in the attachments of your confirmation email. See chapter 1.3 how to use them.

COMMENTATORS SHEET

You may enter and modify your personal profile (curriculum vitae) online at any time in the EMS online registration System under *https://www.rotax-ems.com/brp* whenever you want. It is not mandatory, but if you do not enter anything, the commentator at the track will have nothing to talk about you.

ROTAX GLOBAL APP

The Rotax Global App is the main communication channel and therefore **mandatory for all drivers and entrants**. It is available for smartphones with iOS and Android operating systems. Download the App named ROTAX GLOBAL from the App Store or Google Play and select **RMC Grand Finals** from the list of championships. 1.2. Documents

DRIVER LICENSE

The national / international C-Grade license will be issued by your national karting federation(ASN). It has to be brought **as an original** to the registration office on site. See also class dependent document requirements.

ENTRANT LICENSE

The national / international entrant (competitor) license will be issued by your national karting federation (ASN). It has to be brought **as an original** to the registration office on site. See also class dependent document requirements.

Note:

Drivers under the age of 18 at the time of the event must have an entrant license on behalf of a parent or have to enter the Grand Finals with a team, which holds such a national / international entrant license.

STARTING PERMISSION

The starting permission form is attached to your confirmation email. It is mandatory for the following drivers:

- Drivers holding a national license.
- Drivers holding an international license from a country which is **not mentioned** thereon (see red text).

See also class dependent document requirements mentioned on the next page. All other drivers do not need to do anything with this form.

The starting permission must be signed and stamped by your national karting federation (ASN). It has to be brought **as an original to the registration office** on site and **uploaded in advance before the event** to the EMS online registration system under https://www.rotax-ems.com/brp using your personal EDIT-Code.

ENTRY FORM

Download the already prefilled entry form using the link **DOWNLOAD FORM** in the confirmation email and check the correctness and completeness.

If necessary, modify your data using the link **MODIFY REGISTRATION** in the confirmation email. To get access you will need your personal EDIT-code.

After this, the entry form must be signed electronically by all required persons (driver, entrant, guardian) using the link **SIGN FORM** in the confirmation email. If a person is not at hand, simply forward the email to the appropriate destination.

Note: If you change the contents of the entry form <u>after</u> signing, all persons involved will have to sign again!

1.2.1. Class dependent document requirements

1.2.1.1. 125 MICRO MAX / 125 MINI MAX / 125 JUNIOR MAX

DRIVER LICENSE

Drivers must hold a valid **national** license (junior drivers may also hold an international license Grade C instead) issued by their national karting federation.

ENTRANT LICENSE

Entrants must hold a valid **national / international** license issued by their national karting federation.

STARTING PERMISSION

Foreign drivers who want to participate at the event must have a starting permission signed and stamped by their national karting federation if the driver license does not already include the starting permission for foreign countries.

Note: Read sporting regulations for more details (which will be available soon at https://www.rotax-kart.com).

1.2.1.2. 125 MAX / 125 MAX DD2 / 125 MAX DD2 MASTERS

DRIVER LICENSE

Drivers must hold a valid **international** license grade C issued by their national karting federation.

ENTRANT LICENSE

Entrants must hold a valid **international** license issued by their national karting federation.

Note:
Drivers who are still under the age of 18 at the time of the event
(and therefore do not have the legal capacity) cannot be their own entrant.





1.3. Rotax Global App

1.3.1. Rotax WiFi Connection

You need internet connectivity to run the Rotax Global App. If your smartphone is not already connected to the Internet via your own mobile network, you may connect to the free Rotax WiFi network.

DRIVERS & ENTRANTS

Search for the network named **GF Drivers_Entrants 2019** and connect to it using the corresponding access data you have received in the message body of your confirmation email.

Only one device per driver/entrant can connect to the free Rotax WiFi at the same time. Do not use the Rotax WiFi for purposes other than running the Rotax Global App, otherwise your access will be locked.

1.3.2. Rotax Global App Login

Start the Rotax Global App and select **RMC Grand Finals** from the list of championships if not already done.

DRIVERS

Login to the Rotax Global App using your personal EDIT-Code if not already done. Please note that it is your responsibility to make sure that you are logged in and online throughout the whole event.

ENTRANTS

If it is the first time using the Rotax Global App, you must **register yourself** by entering your email address and a free definable password. If you are already registered, just login with your email address and password if not already done.

If you want to only receive notifications from a driver, **add the driver** by entering his name (optional), starting number (kart number) and category (class). If you want to receive <u>and</u> to confirm notifications on behalf of a driver, **add the driver** using his personal EDIT-Code instead.

1.4. Registration on Site

Before proceeding to the registration office make sure that you have got all documents complete, correctly filled and signed, otherwise you can not register.

If you have a serious irresolvable problem to arrive in time, please contact your local distributor for further information.

At the end of the registration process a picture will be taken from each driver for use in the live stream; afterwards you'll receive your Driver ID.









2. EQUIPMENT

2.1. What will be provided for the Event

EVERY DRIVER WILL RECEIVE FREE OF CHARGE

(AT REGISTRATION ON SITE)

- 1 x driver ID card + lanyard
- 1 x mechanic ID card + lanyard
- 1 x personal sticker set for the race kart (starting numbers, name, country flag)
- Paddock passes + lanyards for supporters
- Wristbands for Welcome- and Driver Party (numbers according to your online party registration)

DRIVERS WILL RECEIVE FREE OF CHARGE, ON A LOAN BASIS

(IN THE PADDOCK)

- Assigned spot in the driver's tent, marked with a personal driver board, which must not be changed
- Half of a table
- Two chairs
- One connection to electricity which must not be placed on the floor.

EVERY DRIVER WILL HAVE ACCESS TO

(IN THE SERVICE PARK)

- Compressed air to inflate the tires
- Tire bead breaker
- Containers with water for tire leakage test
- A tire pole to store the set of tires in parc ferme

PROVIDED TO DRIVERS FREE OF CHARGE, ON A LOAN BASIS

(FOR THE EVENT PERIOD)

- Complete chassis with engine and engine accessories
- Seat for the chassis (driver can select between different available seat sizes)
- Rims for dry tires
- Rims for wet tires and wet tires will be handed out in time in case of high risk of rain only
- Trolley for the chassis
- Toolbox with all standard tools for chassis- and engine setup
- Battery charger with connector for local electrical network

- Lead in different sizes with screws, washers and nuts.
 The use of private owned lead brought for the event is allowed (CIK regulations for fixation of lead apply)
- Optional allowed front sprockets/ MAX and optional allowed primary drives/DD2 (see RMCGF Technical Regulations)
- Optional allowed main jets for the carburettor (see RMCGF Technical Regulations)

CONSUMPTION GOODS WILL BE PROVIDED TO DRIVERS FREE OF CHARGE

(FOR THE EVENT PERIOD)

- All tires which will be used during the event (see RMCGF Technical Regulations)
- Pre-mixed fuel (see RMCGF Technical Regulations)
- Service products: 1 x brake cleaner
 - 1 x multi cleaner
 - 1 x visor cleaner
 - 1 x chain lube (Micro MAX, Mini MAX, Junior MAX and MAX only)

RETURN OF EQUIPMENT AT THE END OF THE EVENT

All equipment provided for the event on a loan basis must be returned in appropriate and clean condition (except tires and consumables). Chassis with engine, trolley, battery charger and optional gear ratios must be returned according to the "Return Instruction" of the respective chassis manufacturer.

Radiator must be drained from water.

Carburettor must be drained from fuel. - Please use the designated fuel containers (marked) located in the park fermé and the drivers tent to empty the carburettor.

Lead must be returned with screws, washers and nuts in the same condition as provided at the beginning of the event (cutting of lead is not allowed). Toolbox must be returned with all tools included as provided at the beginning of the event.

The distribution and return of the equipment is defined in the official event schedule.



NOTE:

For any item which has been provided on a loan basis for the duration of the event and which will not be returned as requested or which has been damaged during the period of the loan, the driver will be charged with a corresponding fee. The driver is responsible for all damages caused by any race accident.

2.2. Personal equipment provided by the driver

Some equipment has to be provided by the drivers themselves - below please find an overview:

- Personal race gear, race suit (preferable in the respective country colours), helmet, shoes and gloves must comply with actual CIK requirements (see CIK Technical Regulations, item 3.2 Equipment Safety).
- Personal transponder with mounting bracket must be provided for the event. The personal transponder ID is required for the online registration for the Rotax MAX Challenge Grand Finals.

The mounting position as well as of when the transponder must be mounted and in operation is defined in the RMCGF technical regulations.

The driver is responsible for the timely charging of the transponder to assure a faultless function during the event.

- Personal data acquisition system (see RMCGF technical Regulations)
- Personal tire pressure gauge
- Personal battery drill
- Personal tools you are used to working with (e.g. wheel alignment gauge...). This year please also have the fixation tool for the starter gear with you as we do not have them available.

Drivers are obliged to bring their own transponders.



NOTE:

During the whole period of the event, drivers are not allowed to expose any brands at their race gear which are competing with the brands BRP, Rotax, Mojo, XPS, Dell'orto, Birel, Praga, Compkart and Sodikart.



Fixation tool for starter gear has to be provided by the drivers in 2019.

3. TRACK

CIRCUITO INTERNAZIONALE NAPOLI


The track is located in Sarno - about 40 km south from Naples and opened in 1999. It has since held several World Karting Championship events and the European Kart Championships.

In 2016 the track changed its face and the majority of Sarno's iconic straights and corners are retained in a new layout. The circuit figures a length of 1547 m, 9 straight, 13 corners with different radius and 1 light chicane between the two segments of the Sarno's power main straight.

4. TRAVEL INFORMATION

4.1. Country Information

IN GENERAL

Time Zone:	Central European Summer Time (UTC +2)
Climate:	Mediterranean climate with mild, wet winters and hot, dry summers. October brings an average temperature of around 18°C, which can reach a high of a very pleasant 22°. The Mediterranean Sea is still at a very warm 23°, with around 6 hours of sunshine per day on average. Evenings can drop to chilly levels with an average low of around 13°C.
Language:	Italian
Electricity:	Standard electrical voltage in Italy is 230V / 50 Hz as opposed to the 110-120 V/60Hz North American standards. Thus, a transformer and an adapter are needed for North American appliances as well as appliances from possible further foreign countries. Power sockets (outlets) are of type F and L - European
	standard electrical socket types: Europlug and Schuko.
Currency:	EURO / €
Alhohol Limit:	Italy has very strict drink driving laws. The alcohol limit is 0,5‰ (0,25 mg/l)
Vaccination:	Usually no special vaccination needed. As Measles cases have been reported in Italy, ensure to have

your Measles vaccinations.

In Italy there is a wide network of free WiFi-connections. But if you need a prepaid phonecard you can either order it online or buy it at the airport or some of the several Mobile phone shops which are nearly in every city. The operators in Italy are: RIM, Wind and Iliad (these are italian brands) or Voda-fone and "3" (Tre) which are international well-known brands. Please feel free to choose the best operator for your needs.













EAT & DRINK

Campania is the land of sun, sea and culture, an area that has distinguished itself since the ancient times for its vast culinary heritage that is rich in unique delicacies. It is the home of pasta and pizza and nevertheless, the region is famous for a wide variety of typical cheeses, traditional salami and liqueurs.

The pizza was invented in Naples by an unknown street baker many centuries ago. The city of pasta - Gragnano (a small town in the Naples metropolitan area) is renowned worldwide for having the best pasta in Italy. Travel along Campania's coastline and you'll find some of the best fish and seafood in Italy. Buffalo Mozzarella started life here over 1.000 years ago and another well-known cheese is Scamorza.

Stroll along the stunning Amalfi Coast and you'll see stepped hillsides covered in lemon groves. Amalfi lemons are renowned for their wonderful flavour and aroma, whether eaten fresh or drunk in limoncello (liqueur).

WHAT TO SEE

Within the province of Campania there is also located the Amalfi Coast - an UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1997 - attracting thousands of tourists from all around the world every year. It is about 1.5 hours away from Salerno and worth a visit.

Naples is the regional capital and the third-largest municipality in Italy after Rome and Milan. Its continuously builtup metropolitan area is one of the most densely populated cities in Europe. Naples' historic city center is the largest in Europe and a UNESCO World Heritage Site with a wide range of culturally and historially significant sites nearby.

Mount Vesuvius is a somma-stratovolcano located 9 km east of Naples. It is best known for its eruption in AD79 that led to the burying and destruction of the Roman city of Pompeii and is the only volcano on the European mainland to have erupted within the last hundred years. Today, it is regarded as one of the most dangerous volcanoes in the world because of 3,000.000 people living nearby.

4.2 How to get there

Sarno is located on the western coast of Campania, in the provice of Salerno, 30 km northeast from the city of Salerno and 40 km east of Naples, the capital of Campania, which has also an international airport.

INTERNATIONAL FLIGHTS

The nearest international airports to Sarno are Naples or Rome:

Naples is approximately 40 m away from Sarno and it takes about 35 min by car or 1 hour by Train to Sarno.

Rome is about 240 km north of Sarno. It takes 2 hours by car and about 3 hours by train.

Distance of Sarno to the race track:

The kart track is located outside of Sarno, just 6 km from the city centre. There is no metro in Sarno and generally no easy accessability with public transportation, so this option is not recommended. We would recommend to take a rental car at your arrival airport.

DRIVING IN ITALY

Traffic travels on the right in Italy. Speed limits in Italy are as follows:


Cities:	31 mph / 50 kph
Open Roads:	55 mph / 90 kph
Highways:	80 mph / 130 kph

Drivers without an EU driving licence are allowed to drive with an official translation or an International Drivers Permit (IDP) that accompanies the foreign licence.

Furthermore, there are several legal regulations that apply for driving in Italy which also need to be fulfilled when driving rental cars. The driver is expected to carry a replacement tire and the respective tools needed, reflective vests for driver and passengers as well as warning triangles. The reflector vest must be worn by any person carrying out repairs when outside the vehicle and the vehicle is stationary on the road.

The warning triangle is mandatory, and it must be displayed on the road to warn oncoming drivers that your vehicle has problems. A replacement bulb set is also mandatory. Firt-aid kit is advised but not compulsory.

The usage of mobile devices is banned and if caught you will be heavily fined.





There are several cities about 30 to 40 min drive by car which are located near the sea, where you can look for rooms like Salerno, Vietri sul Mare, Pompei, Castellammare di Stabia or Torre Annunziata.



4.4. Entry Information / Visa

Italy is - like most of the European States - part of the Schengen area, thus it is possible to move freely between the ses countries. In order to enter this external border, a Schengen visa might be required (see on the map below).



For visa-free countries, the passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond the intended period of stay and need to have a round-trip airline ticket.

The EU has a common list of countries whose citizens must have a visa when crossing the external borders and a list of countries whose citizens are excempt from that requirement. So far, the EU has concluded visa facilitation agreements with the following non-EU countries: Albania, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Cape Verde, FYROM, Georgia, Moldova, Montenegro, Serbia, Russia and Ukraine.

Schengen Visa Application Requirements:

In general, the Schengen visa has to be obtained from the Embassy/Consulate of the country where the main purpose of travel lies. In case you are travelling to more than one Schengen country, the application needs to be made at the Embassy/Consulate where you will be staying for the maximum number of days. In case of equal stay in each of these countries one has to apply at the Schengen country which is first port of entry. In most cases, the request thus must be made at the Embassy/Consulate of Italy.
