1) COVID-19 REGULATIONS UPDATE FOR RMCGF PARTICIPANTS

We would like to inform you about News regarding the procedures for Drivers and Participants of the RMC Grand Finals 2021. **PLEASE NOTE:**

The procedures for un-vaccinated Drivers (younger than 18 years) and/or Red List arrives have been arranged specifically for the RMCGF 2021 and therefore will differ from published standard procedures.

Any changes that may occur, will be communicated to all registered competitors and drivers.

1.1. RULES APPLYING ONLY TO DRIVERS (only effective from December 8th to 18th, 2021)

All Drivers 18 years old or older must have an approved vaccination certificate *1. There are NO excemptions! It is highly recommended, but not mandatory for Drivers below 18 years of age to be vaccinated.

- A) DRIVERS with an <u>approved vaccination certificate *1</u> coming from countries that are eligible to obtain an on-arrival visa (VACCINATED AND FROM NON-RED-LIST COUNTRIES):
 - ▶ Present an approved PCR certificate before boarding the plane, not older than 72 hours
 - ► Undergo three PCR tests in Bahrain (costing BHD 36)*2: upon arrival, on the fifth (5th) day and on the tenth (10th) day after arrival
 - ► No need to quarantine
- B) UN-VACCINATED DRIVERS (BELOW 18 YEARS of age and independent from which country they are coming from):
 - ► Present an approved PCR certificate before boarding the plane, not older than 48 hours
 - ► Undergo three PCR tests in Bahrain (costing BHD 36)*²: upon arrival, on the fifth (5th) day and on the tenth (10th) day after arrival
 - ► Antigen testing daily for 10 days
 - ► No quarantine required (once result of arrival PCR test is confirmed as negative)
- C) <u>All DRIVERS</u> with an <u>approved vaccination certificate *1</u> COMING FROM A RED LIST COUNTRY:
 - ► Present an approved PCR certificate before boarding the plane, not older than 48 hours
 - ► Undergo three PCR tests in Bahrain (costing BHD 36)*²: upon arrival, on the fifth (5th) day and on the tenth (10th) day after arrival
 - ► Antigen testing daily for 10 days
 - ► No quarantine required (once result of arrival PCR test is confirmed as negative)

Referring to the website of the Ministry of Health of the Kingdom Bahrain, **fully vaccinated means:** completed 14 days after the second dose in a two-dose vaccination series (e.g. Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca, etc.) or completed 14 days after administration of a single dose for single-dose vaccination series (e.g. Johnson & Johnson).

1.2. RULES APPLYING TO ENTRANTS, MECHANIC AND SUPPORTERS

HR A

SAKHIR

(only effective from December 8th to 18th, 2021)

Only individuals with an approved vaccination certificate are allowed to enter the facilities during the RMCGF 2021 from December 9th to 18th, 2021.

- A) <u>ALL INDIVIDUALS</u> with an <u>approved vaccination certificate *1</u> coming from countries that are eligible to obtain an on-arrival visa:
 - ► Present an approved PCR certificate before boarding the plane, not older than 72 hours
 - ► Undergo three PCR tests in Bahrain (costing BHD 36)*²: upon arrival, on the fifth (5th) day and on the tenth (10th) day after arrival
 - ► No need to quarantine
- B) <u>ALL INDIVIDUALS</u> with an <u>approved vaccination certificate *1</u> coming from a RED LIST COUNTRY:
 - ▶ Present an approved PCR certificate before boarding the plane, not older than 48 hours
 - ► Undergo three PCR tests in Bahrain (costing BHD 36)*2: upon arrival, on the fifth (5th) day and on the tenth (10th) day after arrival
 - ► Antigen testing daily for 10 days
 - ► No quarantine required (once the result of arrival PCR test is confirmed as negative)

4) ROTAX GLOBAL APP

- 4.1. The Rotax Global App is the main communication channel for the RMC Grand Finals and therefore **mandatory for all drivers and entrants**.
- 4.2. Download the App named **"ROTAX GLOBAL"** from the **App Store** or **Google Play** and select **"RMC Grand Finals"** from the list of championships.
- 4.3. The Rotax Global App offers a bunch of useful features for the race and specially also provides official documents as:
 - Virtual Notice Board: all the latest announcements and decisions from the organizer and race officials, including results, start grids, bulletins, updates, etc.
 - Virtual Briefing: It is mandatory to fully watch the briefings!
 Once you have opened the virtual briefing and watched it, you confirm your attendance and that you have clearly understood the briefing details.
 - Notifications: personalized notifications for individual drivers are immediately retrievable via the App.
