

It is the highlight of the race season and on behalf of BRP-Rotax and all its partners we wish you great success and lots of fun in Portugal.



1. REGISTRATION PROCESS

To guarantee a smooth registration process, we kindly ask you to take the following 4 steps:

DETAILS FOR REGISTRATION PROCESS

1.1. ONLINE REGISTRATION

All qualified drivers must register online at https://www.rotax-ems.com/brp in advance.

Or tab the **REGISTER ONLINE** button in the Grand Finals 2022 section of the **Rotax Website**.

The required password to enter the online registration will be provided by your national Rotax Distributor.

For your online registration please prepare:

- Your Personal Data and those of your Entrant
- Your Passport number
- Your driver License number
- Your personal Transponder number*

- Your Entrants (competitors) License number
- Picture of Driver License and Entrant License (jpg, max. 1MB)

After a successful online registration, you will receive a **confirmation email** with all required documents. See chapter 1.2. how to treat these documents.

The confirmation email also contains your personal EDIT-code and Rotax WiFi access data.

1.1.1. EDIT-CODE

This code is your personal **EDIT-Code** which you will need later on to:

- modify your data, if necessary
- fill up the commentator's sheet
- login to the Rotax Global App (details in chapter 1.3.)

1.1.2. ROTAX WIFI

There are two WiFi-codes (one for You and another one for your Entrant) each consisting of username and password which you can use to connect to the free $\bf Rotax\ WiFi$ on site (see chapter 1.3.1.).

1.1.3. COMMENTATORS SHEET

You may enter and modify your personal profile (curriculum vitae) online at any time in the EMS online registration System under https://www.rotax-ems.com/brp whenever you want. It is not mandatory, but if you do not enter anything, the commentator at the track will have nothing to talk about you.

1.2. DOCUMENTS

1.2.1. DRIVER LICENSE

It is mandatory to have a valid national or international license for 2022! The license has to be brought as an original to the Sporting Check-In on site.

125 MICRO MAX

Drivers must have his/her **8**th birthday during the year of the event and must have his/her **12**th birthday after the year of the event.

Must hold a valid National Karting License and a Starting Permission issued by the responsible ASN.

125 MINI MAX

Drivers must have his/her **10**th birthday during the year of the event and must have his/her **14**th birthday after the year of the event.

Must hold a valid National Karting License and a Starting Permission issued by the responsible ASN.

125 JUNIOR MAX

Drivers must have his/her **12**th birthday during the year of the event and have his/her **15**^{th*} birthday after the year of the event.

Must hold an International Karting License Grade G issued by the responsible ASN. An International entrant license is required.

*A driver with **15 years old during the year** of the event can participate if he/she holds a valid International Karting License Grade G, according to Article 3.4.1. of the CIK International Karting Licenses for Drivers.

125 SENIOR MAX

Drivers must have his/her **14**^{th*} birthday during the year of the event. Must hold a valid International Karting License Grade F or E issued by the responsible ASN. An International entrant license is required.

*If a driver is **14 years old during the year** of the event, he/she must hold a valid International karting license grade F according to CIK/FIA Internaional driver license for karting drivers and code of driving conduct, article 3.4.2.

125 MAX DD2

Drivers must have his/her 15^{th} birthday during the year of the event. Must hold a valid International Karting License Grade E issued by the responsible ASN. An International entrant license is required.

DETAILS FOR REGISTRATION PROCESS

125 MAX DD2 MASTERS

Drivers must have his/her **32**nd birthday during the year of the event. Must hold a valid International Karting License Grade E issued by the responsible ASN.

An International entrant license is required.

PROJECT E20 JUNIOR

Drivers must have his/her **12**^{th*} birthday during the year of the event and his/her **15**^{th*} birthday after the year of the event.

Must hold a valid International Karting License Grade G or a National Karting License (with a Starting Permission) issued by the responsible ASN.

An International entrant license is required, subject to the Driver's license.

*A driver with **15 years old during the year** of the event can participate if he/she holds a valid International Karting License Grade G, according to Article 3.4.1. of the CIK International Karting licenses.

PROJECT E20 SENIOR

Drivers must have his/her **14**th* birthday during the year of the event. Must hold a valid International Karting License Grade F or E or a National Karting License (with a Starting Permission) issued by the responsible ASN. An International entrant license is required, subject to the Driver's license.

*If a driver is **14 years old during the year** of the event, he/she must hold a valid International Karting License grade F according to CIK/FIA Internation drivers licenses for karting and code of driving conduct, article 3.4.2.

1.2.2. ENTRANT LICENSE

Entrants must hold an International Entrant (Competitor) License which will be issued by your National Karting Federation (ASN) affiliated to the FIA.

It has to be brought as an Original to the Sporting Check-In on site.

Drivers who are still under age (and therefore do not have full legal capacity) cannot be their own entrant.



NOTE:

Drivers under the age of 18 (at the time of the event) **can not be** their own entrant. Those drivers **must have an entrant license** on behalf of a parent/guardian or **have to enter the Grand Finals with a team**, which holds such a National / International Entrant License.




DETAILS FOR REGISTRATION PROCESS

1.2.3. STARTING PERMISSION

A Starting Permission is mandatory for the following drivers/entrants:

- All Drivers and Entrants holding a National License must have a Starting Permission issued by the responsible ASN.
- All Drivers and Entrants holding a International Karting License must have a Starting Permission issued by the responsible ASN in such form as they might deem convenient.

The Starting Permission has to be brought as an **Original to the Sporting Check-In Office on site** and **uploaded in advance before the event to the EMS Online Registration System**under https://www.rotax-ems.com/brp using your personal **EDIT-Code.**



1.2.4. ENTRY FORM

Download the already prefilled Entry Form using the link **DOWNLOAD FORM** in the confirmation email and check the correctness and completeness.

If necessary, modify your data using the link **MODIFY REGISTRATION** in the confirmation email. To get access you will need your personal **EDIT-code**. After this, the entry form must be signed electronically by all required persons (Driver, Entrant, Guardian) using the link **SIGN FORM** in the confirmation email. If a person is not at hand, simply forward the email to the appropriate destination.

1.3. ROTAX GLOBAL APP

The Rotax Global App is the main communication channel and therefore **mandatory** for all drivers and entrants.

Download the App named ROTAX GLOBAL from the **App Store** or **Google Play** and select RMC Grand Finals from the list of championships.

Although the App is self-explanatory a **detailed user guide** can be found under https://www.rotax-kart.com/en/EVA-System/Event-Management. A setup guide for iOS and Android is attached to your confirmation email.

1.3.1. ROTAX WIFI CONNECTION

You need internet connectivity to run the Rotax Global App.

If your smartphone is not already connected to the Internet via your own mobile network, you may connect to the free Rotax WiFi network.

DRIVERS & ENTRANTS

Search for the network named GF Drivers_Entrants 2022 and connect to it using the corresponding access data you have received in the message body of your confirmation email.

Only one device per driver/entrant can connect to the free Rotax WiFi at the same time. Do not use the Rotax WiFi for purposes other than running the **Rotax Global App**, otherwise your access will be blocked.



1.3.2. ROTAX GLOBAL APP LOGIN

Start the **Rotax Global App** and select RMC Grand Finals from the list of championships if not already done.

DRIVERS

Login to the **Rotax Global App** using your personal **EDIT-Code** if not already done. Please note that it is your responsibility to make sure that you are logged in and online throughout the whole event.

ENTRANTS

If it is the first time using the **Rotax Global App**, you must register yourself by entering your email address and a free definable password. If you are already registered, just login with your email address and password if not already done.

If you want to only receive notifications from a driver, add the driver by entering his name (optional), starting number (kart number) and category (class). If you want to receive <u>and</u> to confirm notifications on behalf of a driver, add the driver using his personal **EDIT-Code** instead.

1.4. SPORTING CHECK-IN ON SITE

Depending on the situation on site, we will make use of our Ticketing System to avoid gatherings of people in front of the Check-In Office.

In this case please get your waiting ticket and return as soon as you are notified to proceed by Push Notification via the Rotax Global App or on the screen.

Before visiting the Check-In Office please make sure that you have got all documents complete, correctly filled and signed, otherwise you can not register.

2. EQUIPMENT

2.1. WHAT WILL BE PROVIDED FOR THE EVENT

2.1.1. EVERY DRIVER WILL RECEIVE FREE OF CHARGE

(AT SPORTING CHECK-IN ON SITE)

- 1 x Driver ID card, lanyard + wristband
- 1 x Mechanic ID card, lanyard + wristband
- 1 x Entrant ID card, lanyard + wristband
- 1 x personal sticker set for the race kart (starting numbers, name, country flag)

2.1.2. DRIVERS WILL RECEIVE FREE OF CHARGE, ON A LOAN BASIS (IN THE PADDOCK)

 Assigned spot in the driver's tent, marked with a personal driver board.

It is **NOT ALLOWED to change the location**.

- Table
- Two chairs
- One connection to electricity which must not be placed on the floor.

2.1.3 EVERY DRIVER WILL HAVE ACCESS TO (IN THE SERVICE PARK)

- Compressed air to inflate the tires
- Tire bead breaker
- Containers with water for tire leakage test









EQUIPMENT COMBUSTION

PROVIDED FOUIPMENT FOR COMBUSTION KARTS

2.1.4. PROVIDED TO DRIVERS FREE OF CHARGE, ON A LOAN BASIS (FOR THE EVENT PERIOD)

- Complete chassis with engine and engine accessories
- Seat for the chassis (driver can select between different available sizes)
- Rims for dry tires // Rims for wet tires and wet tires will be handed out in time in case of high risk of rain only
- Trolley for the chassis
- Toolbox with all standard tools for chassis- and engine setup
- Battery charger with connector for local electrical network
- Lead in different sizes with screws, washers and nuts.
 The use of private owned lead brought for the event is allowed (CIK regulations for fixation of lead apply)
- Optional allowed front sprockets/MAX and optional allowed primary drives/DD2 (see RMCGF Technical Regulations)
- Optional allowed main jets for the carburettor (see RMCGF Technical Regulations)

2.1.5. CONSUMPTION GOODS WILL BE PROVIDED TO DRIVERS FREE OF CHARGE

(FOR THE EVENT PERIOD)

- All tires which will be used during the event (see RMCGF Technical Regulations)
- Pre-mixed fuel (see RMCGF Technical Regulations)

Service products:

1 x brake cleaner 1 x multi cleaner

1 x visor cleaner 1 x chain lube (Micro MAX, Mini MAX,

Junior MAX and MAX only)

2.1.6. RETURN OF EQUIPMENT AT THE END OF THE EVENT

All equipment provided for the event on a loan basis must be returned in appropriate and clean condition (except tires and consumables).

- Chassis with engine, trolley, battery charger and optional gear ratios must be returned according to the "Return Instruction" of the respective chassis manufacturer. Slick and/or wet tires must be dismounted from the rims.
- Radiator must be drained from water.
- Carburettor must be drained from fuel. Please use the designated fuel containers (marked) to empty the carburettor.
- Lead must be returned with screws, washers and nuts in the same condition as provided (cutting of lead is not allowed).
- Toolbox must be returned with all tools included as provided.

ONLY COMBUSTION





NOTE:

Any item provided on a loan basis for the event which will not be returned as requested or has been damaged,

will be charged with a

corresponding fee.

The driver is also responsible for all damages caused by a race accident.









PROVIDED EQUIPMENT FOR ELECTRIC KARTS

2.1.4. PROVIDED TO DRIVERS FREE OF CHARGE, ON A LOAN BASIS (FOR THE EVENT PERIOD)

- Complete chassis, including data logging system with electric powertrain and batteries
- Seat for the chassis (driver can select between different available sizes)
- Rims for dry tires // Rims for wet tires and wet tires will be handed out in time in case of high risk of rain only
- Trolley for the chassis
- Battery charger and power supply is included along with a work table and awning.

2.1.5. CONSUMPTION GOODS WILL BE PROVIDED TO DRIVERS FREE OF CHARGE

(FOR THE EVENT PERIOD)

 All tires which will be used during the event (see RMCGF Technical Regulations)

Service products:

1 x brake cleaner 1 x multi cleaner

1 x visor cleaner

2.1.6. RETURN OF EQUIPMENT AT THE END OF THE EVENT

All equipment provided for the event on a loan basis must be returned in appropriate and clean condition

- Chassis should be returned fully assembled including seat.
- Slick and wet tires have to be dismounted from rims.
- Lead must be returned with screws, washers and nuts in the same condition as provided at the beginning of the event (cutting of lead is not allowed).

PERSONAL FOUIPMENT PROVIDED BY DRIVERS

2.2. PERSONAL EQUIPMENT PROVIDED BY THE DRIVER

Some equipment has to be provided by the drivers themselves - below please find an overview:

- Personal race gear, race suit (preferable in the respective country colours), helmet, rib protector, shoes and gloves must comply with actual CIK requirements (CIK/FIA Technical regulation article 7).
 - Visors must feature the logo of the manufacturer and the production date.
- Personal tire pressure gauge
- Own facemasks and disinfectant
- Personal battery drill
- Personal tools you are used to working with (e.g. wheel alignment gauge...).
 This year please also have the fixation tool for the starter gear with you.
- NECK PROTECTORS ARE MANDATORY for the Rotax 125 Micro MAX and Rotax 125 Mini MAX categories



- Personal data acquisition system (see RMCGF technical Regulations)
- Personal transponder with mounting bracket
 The personal transponder ID is required for the online registration for the RMC Grand Finals for combustion category drivers.

Electric categories have to rent their transponders provided at the event.

ALL DRIVERS, PLEASE READ:

The mounting position and when the transponder must be mounted and in operation is defined in the RMCGF sporting regulations.

The driver is responsible for the timely charging of the transponder to assure a faultless function during the event.

2.2.1. TRANSPONDERS

Following Transponders of AMB/MYLAPS are allowed in the Rotax MAX Challenge Grand Finals:

- MYLAPS classic transponder
- AMB TranX 160
- MYLAPS FLEX transponder
- AMB TranX 160 with battery

COMBUSTION DRIVERS are obliged to bring their own transponders. **ELECTRIC DRIVERS** have to rent the transponders provided by the organizer.

ALL DRIVERS



TEAM & RACE SUITS

During the whole period of the event, **drivers are NOT ALLOWED** to expose any brands at their race gear which are competing with the brands BRP, Rotax, Mojo, XPS, Dell'orto, BirelArt, Praga and Sodikart.



Fixation tool for starter gear has to be provided by the drivers.



TRACK INFO SHORT INTRODUCTION OF THE TRACK

3. TRACK

Once more the Rotax MAX Challenge Grand Finals returns to the Kartódromo Internacional do Algarve (KIA) which is located along the Atlantic coastline of the Algarve region in the south of Portugal. With its warm weather and beautiful beaches, surrounded by a mountainous natural landscape, it is rich with culture, great food and leisure.

The Autódromo do Algarve is the favourite home to motorsport events in Portimão and one of the premier racing facilities worldwide, with its 5-star hotel spa resort and serviced apartments. The kart circuit was completed in 2010 as part of a huge modern complex and overlooks the big race circuit, which also plays host to various international car and motorcycle events annually. It is just a 15 minute drive from the cities of Portimão and Lagos, situated within good driving distance from two international airports: Faro (70km) and Lisbon (200km).

The kart track offers a very nice and fast layout to drive with a smooth surface over a varying degree of elevation. It has many different types of corners that can make the contrast between drivers during the competition, with good 'user-friendly' kerbs defining the apex and edge of the circuit. There is a fast 400-metre-long straight and without any doubt, plenty of places to pass throughout the lap.

The Portugal the power plugs are Type C and Type F. The standard voltage is 230 V with 50Hz.







